

Welcome to Fingask Castle & Estate

Fingask is a traditional rural estate of 240 acres nestling in the hills above the main road between Perth and Dundee. The Threiplands of Fingask were famed in the 18th and 19th centuries for their hospitality.



The Stone Staircase

Leads from the Long Gallery to the ground floor of the castle where you can hold your drinks reception complete with mobile bar area. A door opens from the main hall out to the Fountain Courtyard.

The Castle Chapel

A small family chapel seating up to 22 guests. Couples may have their ceremony relayed by video to the castle's drawing room, where larger groups can gather to watch in a less formal setting.

A numinous room - part of the medival Castle.







The Long Gallery

The Long Gallery seats up to 100 guests for weddings or 30 guests for dinner.



The Bridal Wing

The bridal wing has three double bedrooms each with a handsome four poster bed. Every Fingask couple has the choice of using "Aunt Effie's" room.

These castle bedrooms, like other estate accommodation, are not part of the venue hire, but can be hired seperately for the night of the wedding.







The Old Library

An intimate room for small parties up to 16 people.

The room is lined with fascinating books collected by the Threiplands over many generations.

The Drawing Room

This is a comfortable informal room available for use as part of the drinks reception area.

It can also seat up to 16 guests for dinner, still allowing space to retire by the fireside.





The Fountain Courtyard


Outside the castle is the Fountain Courtyard, where large parties can mingle informally.

The fountain itself is made from a 19th centuary stone heraldic vase with stags heads and the Threipland arms.



Outdoor Weddings

Fingask has a range of outdoor locations each with their own charm. In the (unlikely!) event of rain the Amber Room overlooks the gardens towards the silvery Tay. The chapel and the castle offer other alternatives.





Ossian's Lawn

Couples can get married almost anywhere they like in the Fingask garden but we think that Ossian's Lawn is like an outside room making it an especially suitable enclosed private space for outdoor ceremonies.

We have 150 outdoor chairs which we will put up on the morning of the ceremony along with a red carpet aisle. At 2-3pm in the summer the sun shines along the full length of the lawn. The newly married couple can then parade down the grass paths to the Fountain Coutyard infront of the castle for the drinks reception.





The Fingask Pavilion Great Hall

Guests may be dropped by car or coach at the front of a grand staircase which is guarded by dragons leading to the balcony surrounding the Fingask Pavilion.

The Great Hall of the Pavilion is a useful size for weddings between 60 and 150 people leaving room for a dance floor and people to cluster in front of the bar leaving the Amber Room as a reception area.

The Amber Room

The Amber Room is a useful space for weddings of between 30 and 60 guests with room for dancing around the grand piano.





Asian Weddings

Lots of possibilities! Lots of room. The Fingask Pavilion with its optional extension can seat over 300 people for ceremonies including fire ceremonies and henna parties. We can adapt Fingask to your wishes.



What Fingask Castle Provides

- Exclusive use of the Pavilion, front lawns, Fountain Courtyard, ground floor and 1st floor of the castle for exploring and photographs.

- Use of two grand pianos in the Long Gallery of the castle and The Amber Room.

- Pavilion with heating and lighting.
- Running of the bar and drinks staff throughout your day and night.
 Bar licence on a Friday and Saturday until 1.30am, Sunday to Thursday until 12am.
- Options for bringing in your own still and sparkling wines or selecting from Fingask Castle's own wine list which is on a sale or return basis.
- Panel of carefully selected caterers to choose from.
- All glassware, tables, furniture, crockery, cutlery, 40cm round mirror centre plates or rustic log slices for each dining table and white table linens.

- Round and square cake stand and knife.
- PA system with dock and wireless microphones in the Pavilion

There is room for up to 70 people to sleep on the estate within easy walking distance from the castle and Pavilion.

- 1 Twin bedroom

The former castle laundry with high ceilings and a large lawn. The knock about tennis court and outdoor heated swimming pool are just over the hedge.

Sleeps 3 with room for put-me-up

- 1 Double bedroom
- 1 Single bedroom


Sir Stuart's House

There is a seperate twin bedded 'Bothy' with en suite facilities and TV.






An intimate hideaway for a happy couple to spend the night.

Sitting in a beautifully tranquil spot, right on the edge of the Fingask Loch is a traditional boat house with a boat you can use. Lifejackets must be worn! There is also a sauna with room for about 5 people. The balcony is popular for a glass of wine and a romantic meal.

The Potting Sheds

The Potting sheds are a group of nine twin bedded rooms. Backed against the walled garden. Each pod has its own en-suite luxury shower and toilet. Complimentary toiletry packs, tea and coffee are available in each room. One disabled friendly unit which has grab bars in the bathroom and a shower chair is available upon request.

The Potting Sheds are a few minutes walk through the woods along a lamp lit path to the Pavilion.

The Tufted Duck, in Rait village is a pleasant eatery a 5 minute walk from the Potting Sheds. Here you will be able to get sandwiches and hot meals (see our website for opening times).

The Potting Sheds can each be booked on a one night or more basis or book all 9 for a bargain price.


FAMOUS FOR OUR CRACKLING


